

## WSA moves to new Student Organization Center

KALAMAZOO- The Western Student Association (WSA) will be making the move to the new Student Organization Center (SOC) located in the Bernhard Center, September 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> along with 35 other Registered Student Organizations (RSO's).

The SOC aims to facilitate community and collaboration between RSO's as well as increase the validity of the organizations on campus. The WSA hopes to lead in these efforts as its goals throughout the year are based on The Three C's: Communication, Collaboration, and Community.

The SOC is located behind the Bernhard Center, formally inhabited by Auxiliary Enterprises. It will be open from 9 a.m.-5 p.m. and accessible 24 hours with a Bronco ID. Its features include offices, cubicles, and pods for 35 assigned RSO's, a conference room with state of the art communication technology, a graphic arts design space and team, and a kitchenette. There will also be storage space for RSO's not assigned an office. All students are encouraged to visit the space.
